Peking University Dongfang Scholarships Admission Information for Autumn 2023

Founded in 1898, Peking University is a well-known university in China. Peking University gathers a group of outstanding experts and scholars from China and across the world by its commitment to excellent teaching and research, adherence to the academic spirit of freedom and inclusiveness. The theme of Dongfang Scholarships is 'Understanding China'. Through thematic course studies, high-end conversations, in-depth research on the practice of China's reform and opening-up, and Chinese history and culture exploring, scholars' understanding of China will be deeply enhanced. By understanding the reform and development of China's governance, economy and society, exploring innovative ideas and problem-solving paths, and exchanging thoughts of diverse civilizations, the sense of 'a Community of Shared Future for Mankind' will be enhanced, the new structure of global development and governance will be inspired, and a platform for the innovation of knowledge and ideas is provided for the purposes above. Rooted in China and gathering global resources, Peking University Dongfang Scholarships is dedicated to making positive contributions to the construction of a world-class international intellectual highland and academic community with Peking University style and Chinese characteristics.

1. Dongfang Scholarships

Launched in 2019, Dongfang Scholarships is a 12-week session focusing on governance. Scholars are mainly from government departments, political parties, think tanks and academia, who are representatives of outstanding young and middle-aged leaders in the world.

Content for Dongfang Scholarships

- Thematic course study

Dongfang Scholarships selects outstanding professors of Peking University and experts from relevant government departments and think tanks, who are highly-achieved and influential in their research fields, to give lectures. Focusing on the theme of 'Understanding China', Dongfang Scholarships on Governance consist of five modules, namely economics and management; politics and international relations; governance; philosophy, law and society; history and culture. The courses cover a wide range of topics including poverty alleviation, party politics, Chinese diplomacy, macroeconomics, innovation and development, rural and agricultural policies, public health, public policies, the Belt and Road Initiative, and will provide scholars with comprehensive interpretations of China and the world's development.

-Chinese language courses

Scholars are provided with Chinese language courses 2 class hours per week, at the size of 10-15 people per class, taught by teachers from School of Chinese as a Second Language of Peking University.

-Field trips

During the program, scholars are organized to visit relevant government departments, enterprises, provinces to conduct in-depth research and practice, and discuss with department leaders and experts to let them fully understand China's economic development and society models, while deepening the experience of China's development in a panoramic and three-dimensional way from practice. Through the investigation of China's history and culture, scholars will experience and gain a better understanding.

-Symposium

A series of seminars and experience-sharing sessions are arranged. The seminars have a variety of forms, including presentations, peer reviews, group reports, discussions with relevant national ministries and commissions, etc., with feedback from faculty accordingly. Scholars are encouraged to share their own views on specific topics, and actively exchange their country's practical experience with other fellow scholars. By building an equal and interactive communication platform, understanding will be promoted, consensus will be enhanced, and

progress will be achieved together.

-Graduation

After successfully completing courses, field trips, symposiums, presentations and other requirements, scholars will receive a certificate of completion from Peking University and become Peking University alumni.

- 1. Non-Chinese citizens who hold a valid foreign passport;
- 2. Healthy and free of diseases that are restricted from entry by the Chinese health and quarantine authority or those that may affect public health;
- 3. Abide by the laws and regulations of Chinese government and the rules and regulations of Peking University;
- 4. Hold a bachelor's degree, aged 25-55 years old;
- 5. Master a certain academic and research level; having certain leadership and experience in the field of study and occupation;
- 6. Sufficient English proficiency for teaching and learning;
- 7. Interested in China's development and ambitious to engage in China-related work.
- -How to apply
- 1. After being recommended by Chinese embassy of various countries, Peking University will start the reviewing for the applicants;
- 2. Applicants are required to log in to Peking University International Student Online Application System by the deadline and submit all the materials as required;

Note: Peking University will send corresponding application guides (including required application materials) to applicants who have passed the preliminary review;

3. Peking University will distribute relevant admission materials to successful applicants.

Master degree programs information

In 2023, Peking University (PKU) will enroll foreign students to study for master degree through the "Application + Examination" method, assessing the applicant's comprehensive quality and ability.

Unless otherwise specified by the enrollment department (or project), the basic study period for Master students is 2 or 3 years.

- -Application qualification
- 1. Non-Chinese citizens with foreign passports, good health, good moral standards, and comply with Chinese laws, regulations and school rules;
- 2. Applicants for a master's degree must have a bachelor's degree. Applicants who graduated from non-Chinese universities must hold a bachelor's degree approved by the Chinese Ministry of Education (jump-starters during undergraduate studies are not recognized);
- 3. Academic performance and language capability must reach the standards of the major.

-How to apply

Step 1: Online application

Log in Peking University international students service system (www.studyatpku.com) for online registration; after successfully signing up, download and print 'Peking University application form for international students', and then put a photo and a signature onto it.

Application path: choose 'sign up for application' and insert the program code:

For the master's program: PKUDF-MA

Step 2: Submit the paper materials

- 1. 'Peking University application form for international students' (with signature and photo);
- 2. The highest degree certificate, which should be the original or notarized copy in Chinese or English.

Note: The fresh graduates need to provide an expected graduation certificate or a certificate of enrollment, and it is necessary to submit the degree certificate after being pre-admitted.

- 3. The official transcript, which should be original or notarized copy in Chinese or English.
- 4. Personal statement (including research plan, about 1500 words for the master program, written from be downloaded can template The English. Chinese or in http://www.isd.pku.edu.cn/down/shen/ru/detail/4274.html).
- 5. Two recommendation letters from professors or associate professors (or experts with technical downloaded can be template The majors. relevant titles) in http://www.isd.pku.edu.cn/down/shen/ru/detail/4273.html. The recommendation letters should be original copy in Chinese or English.
- 6. If the first language of applicant is non-English, it is required to submit TOEFL iBT (100 points or higher) or GRE (315 points or higher) transcripts or other certificates that reflect English level. Please refer to admission brochures of various English teaching projects for detailed requirements.
- 7. Copy of passports, which must be an ordinary passport that is still valid at least one year after

admission.

- 8. Personal research outcomes, published academic articles summary, and other original research results (if available).
- 9. Other proof documents required by the department.

Please send all the application materials above to the International Student Division before the application deadline.

-Time Schedule

- 1. Application deadline: (May 30th, 2023.
- 2. The admission decision and the admission notification will be sent by email before July 31st.
- 3. In general, the autumn semester is from September to January (next year), and the spring semester is from February to June. A new academic year starts from the autumn semester, and the estimated registration time is in September (subject to the admission notification and the academic calendar).
